The Psalmist gives us the answer in the 91 chapter and the second verse.

I will say to the LORD, "My refuge and my fortress,
My God, in whom I trust!"

New American Standard Bible (NASB)

I recall listening to a Christian who was ministering in the red light district of a city, with gang warfare ready to explode any moment, and he told his listeners that he could not think of any safer place to be than there *because* he was in the center of God's Will.

God's safety for us is having a deep seated peace and fullness of joy that regardless of where we are, we are in the center of God's will, and in that place, His refuge and fortress for us is the serenity of His presence in the midst of chaos.

So, perhaps a bigger question needs to concern us here. Instead of looking for the 'where can I go for Safety', let's ask the 'Who do I seek for protection'?
